### ABOUT THE JOURNALISTS' CHARITY

The amount the charity raises through donations varies each year, but typically ranges from £250,000 - £500,000 and is comprised of personal donations, industry support, sponsorship of events, and gifts in wills and legacies.

As a nationwide organisation supporting journalists from all sectors across the UK, the charity offers help, advice and financial assistance to any existing or former journalist struggling through hard times.

Since the beginning of 2020, the charity has provided support to hundreds of journalists impacted by the pandemic and more recently the cost of living crisis. The charity has also funded essential

safety kit for freelance journalists covering Russia's invasion of Ukraine.

In 2021, the charity launched a pioneering and unique assistance scheme called the first jobs fund, designed to offer essential support to young journalists just starting their career. Since then more than 50 new journalists have been given financial assistance to help them overcome some of the challenges which act as a barrier to entry to the industry. This includes support with accommodation, relocation and transport.

The charity is just about to launch a new focus on training and skills to help journalists develop their careers at a time of great uncertainty across the industry.
